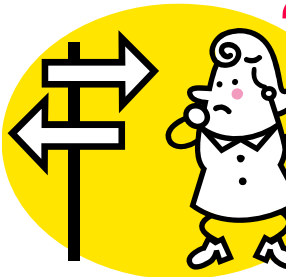


Choose Your Own Verb-venture! (Perfect Verb Edition)



Does your verb have a prefix?

Yes!

Not so much.

OK, great! Now you know you are looking at a Niphal, Hiphil, Hophal, or Hitpaal verb. What does the prefix look like?

Good! Three stems have no prefix in the perfect: Qal, Piel, and Pual. Now, does your verb have a *dagesh forte* in its middle root consonant?

הַתְּ

הִתְּ

הִי

הִי

Nope.

Yes indeed.

It's a **Hitpaal!**
Be *reflexively* excited!

This is the rare *causative-passive* **Hophal!**
What a find!

You've got a **Hiphil** on your hands!
Cause for celebration!

Congrats!
It's a *passive* little **Niphal!**

It's your friendly *simple active* **Qal!**

Which is under the first root consonant, *hireq* or *qibbutz*?

hireq

qibbutz

Wow!
Intense! It's a **Piel!**

It's an *intensive-passive* **Pual!**
